

About the Show:

The 6th Annual Panama City Artists' Show and Sale is an annual exhibit created in a partnership between the Visual Arts Center and the Panama City Artists to showcase the talents and quality of the Panama City Artists to the residents and tourists of Bay County.

Eligibility:

All 2007 members of the Panama City Artists who have paid dues by February 1, 2007 are eligible to submit their works into this juried members show. There is no entry fee; only a current Panama City Artists membership is required.

About the Juror:

Tricia Collins is a former Senior Critic at Yale University, New York Curator and Gallerist. She more recently taught in the Museum Studies Program at University of South Florida. Tricia Collins is currently serving as the Executive Director of the Gadsden Arts Center in Quincy, Florida.

Submission Guidelines:

All interested members of the Panama City Artists must submit 3 pieces by February 1, 2007. These pieces will be juried and one piece out of the 3 submitted will be selected for exhibition. In theme with the purpose of this exhibition, the PCA requires that all artwork for this exhibit must be for sale.

Pieces should not exceed 36 inches in any dimension due to space limitations. The pieces must be original work (no copies, reproductions, prints or giclees) and be no

more than four years old. It is required that all pieces must not have been previously displayed at the Visual Arts Center, and not shown in a professional gallery or show in a 50 mile radius in the past 2 years.

The Panama City Artists and the Visual Arts Center reserve the right to reject any works deemed unsuitable for display at this public event.

Pieces may be submitted one of three ways:

1. By Slides, Artist Name and Title of Work must be written on each Slide
2. Digital Images, Image should be no smaller than 4" x 6" and a minimum DPI of 72 to be provided on a CD. The file name should include Artist Name, Title of Work, and Number (1, 2, 3) (example ArtistName.TitleofWork.1.jpg) Files will be accepted in the following formats: .jpg .gif .tif
3. Photographs, Photos should be no larger than 4" x 6" and include Artist Name and Title of Work on the back of each photo .

Entries should be received by February 1st, 2007, all entries received after this date will not be eligible for exhibit.

Artists will be notified by or on February 23rd of the results of the jurying.

Hanging Requirements:

1. All work must be presentation ready and be able to fit through a standard doorway. No one entry may exceed 75 lbs..
2. If your piece is intended to hang on the wall then it must be wired for hanging in a sturdy and professional manner. If your piece is not intended to hang on a wall, it will require a display base, pedestal or glass case and must be noted as such in your submission.

Sale of Artwork:

In theme with the purpose of this exhibition, the PCA requires that all artwork for this exhibit must be for sale. The Visual Arts Center will receive a 25% commission, and the Panama City Artists will receive a 5% commission. The price listed on your submission form must include these commissions (totaling 30%). The Visual Arts Center will handle all sales for this exhibit. Once a piece has been sold, the VAC will contact the artist with the details. Payment for any pieces sold will be given to the artist within 30 days after the close of the exhibition.

Insurance & Liability:

The Visual Arts Center of Northwest Florida and the Panama City Artists will not be responsible for any damage incurred in transit. All reasonable care will be taken with original art. The Visual Arts Center, its officers, directors, employees, volunteers, members or anyone connected with the exhibition will not be responsible for loss or damage however caused. Your entry into this exhibit constitutes agreement with these terms and conditions.

“Meet the Artists” Opening Reception:

There will be a “Meet the Artists” opening reception for this exhibit on Friday, March 2, 2007 from 6 – 8 pm. All artists are encouraged to come, and invite their friends and family for this free reception.

Peoples Choice Award:

All persons who come to see the exhibit on the opening night will be given a Peoples Choice ballot to vote on their favorite piece. The winner of this contest will be featured on the promotional material for next year’s annual exhibit at the Visual Arts Center.
