Exhibition Education Interaction

Membership in *Panama City Artists* is open to all artists and supporters of the arts ages 16 and up. Membership is for a calendar year from Jan 1 to Dec 31. *Panama City Artists* mission is to promote the practice of visual arts through exhibition, education, and interaction.

PCA offers a full calendar or membership benefits for artists and supporters of the arts through its four teams: Membership and Records, Activities, Community Involvement, and Communications.

Membership and Record Team keeps *PCA* membership information, publishes an Art Instructors Directory (available to potential art students online and at select venues), coordinates the Speakers Bureau (for artists that are willing to make public appearances), and keeps up to date information about other arts organizations.

Activities Team coordinates several members-only exhibits throughout the year: Annual Show and Sale at the Visual Arts Center, Marina Civic Center exhibits, and the Annual Commission Free Sale. This team also coordinates the art exhibit (open to non-members) at the Bay County Fair. *PCA* art workshops are the 2nd Saturday of each month from 9am to 12noon. The Activities Team hosts a monthly social with a presentation or guest speaker on the 3rd Tuesday of each month at 6:00pm, location varies. In addition to exhibits, monthly socials, and workshops, the Activities Team also coordinates field trips, studio tours, and social events.

Community Involvement Team coordinates the *Art in Businesses* and *Art in Public Places* programs, ensuring continual opportunities for *PCA* members to exhibit their art- Sherman Arcade, Bay County Library, City and County Administrative buildings, empty storefront windows, public outdoor spaces, etc. This team also organizes an annual scholarship, group fundraiser, and community service project. Members of the Community Involvement Team attend community meetings to stay informed about local arts related events and pass those opportunities on to *PCA* members. This team works closely with the Visual Arts Center and Downtown Improvement Board, assists with local art festivals and events, and continually seeks out opportunities for *PCA* members.

Communications Team relays all information to current members via phone, mail, email, website, Facebook and MySpace. *PCA* strives to keep members informed of *PCA* events *and* community art events. This team handles all marketing and public relations for *Panama City Artists*.

Through these four teams, *Panama City Artists* provides its members with endless opportunities to exhibit their art, further their art education, and interact with other artists and supporters of the arts. Most exhibition, education, and interaction opportunities within *PCA* are free for members, but in some cases an exhibit or workshop may involve a small fee.
